## **MARKHAM PUBLIC LIBRARIES LAUNCH ELECTRONIC BOOKS**

Markham Public Libraries (MPL) is providing a new opportunity for customers to access information with the introduction of **eBooks** through netLibrary and COOL (Consortium of Ontario Libraries). **eBooks** are full-text electronic versions of published books that customers can search, borrow, read and return over the Internet. The **eBook** collection features an extensive collection from leading publishers of more than 8,200 books covering subject areas such as business, careers, computers, politics, philosophy, history, health, parenting, and literature.

**eBooks** are fully catalogued and integrated into HIP (Horizon Information Portal), MPL's online catalogue system. To check out **eBooks** users must first register for a free netLibrary account through Markham Public Libraries' website or from a workstation within any MPL library.
